079. (5/18) **CHAIRMAN'S INTRODUCTION.**

David Lloyd-Williams welcomed members asked if we had heard further from Huttons Ambo. Gail confirmed that this was not the case and that we would progress the boundary as the existing Malton parish boundary.

080. (5/18) **WORK THROUGH CONSULTATION DOCUMENT AND PROPOSED MAP**

Page 12 – TM2 ensure that the text list is the same as the map list and provide references i.e. TM2-1, TM2-2 etc.

Page 13 – TM4-2 and TM4-3 wrong way round. TM6 move position of shading so it does not incorporate rear gardens.

Page 14 – TM8-2 southern by pass reposition. TM8-3 create this to show link road from Broughton Road to Musley Bank as per Ben's suggestion.

Page 17 – AQ1 add the word permanent to the 7.5 ton HGV ban.

Page 20 – RC1 extend brown line to the south east of Railway Street Bridge. Jill Thompson highlighted the outstanding Habitat Regulation Assessment issue.

Page 24 – E3 ensure that the text list is the same as the map list and again providing references.

Page 28 – Paragraph 2, take out Counting House.

Page 32 – T9 Orchard fields, appears as HD9 on map, and requires alteration.

Page 33 – Paragraph 4, add that Ryedale may need to adapt and amend the Conservation Appraisals to suit their purpose.

Page 37 – HD3 Malton Conservation Area. Enclose boundary line on map to make it more identifiable.

Page 38 – HD4 Old Malton Conservation Area. Ben asked if we could have sight of this document as it had not been circulated. Jill asked for more emphasis on the importance of the open space within Old Malton.

Page 43 – check population estimates.

Page 49 – N1 write to landowner.

Page 50 – CIL. Put Town Council matters first and clarify that Ryedale's are for next times plan consideration.
